Scholarship Participation Rules:

- 1. Must be a high school graduate or current college student.
- 2. Must attend an accredited college or university.
- 3. Must be enrolled in at least 9 credit hours per semester.
- 4. Parent must be a current full time employee of the Department of Public Safety
- 5. Must submit an essay of 250 words on your goals and why you are the best candidate to receive this scholarship.
- 6. Must submit a transcript.
- 7. Must submit a photograph.
- 8. Must complete and submit the application.
- 9. Recipients may re-apply for the scholarship each year.
- 10. Applicants may major in any subject.
- 11. First time applicants will be given first priority.

Rules for awarding of a Scholarship

- 1. Recipients will be awarded a cashier's check to be used for tuition or books at the accredited college of their choice.
